# **MOSAICS Student Uniform Policy**

### -Final approval lies with Administration or Designee-

The intent of the uniform student dress code is to encourage students to experience a greater sense of school identity, improve student behavior, and provide a safer school environment. Students not in compliance with the uniform policy will have parents called to bring them appropriate uniform clothing to school or will need to be picked up.

### **Daily Expectations:**

- Collared polo shirt or collared button down shirt in any single solid color, below waistline in length
  - a long sleeve shirt, turtleneck shirt, or undershirt of a single solid color may be worn under collared polo or button down shirt for warmth; no lace camis; undershirts must be tucked in
  - shirts must have all buttons fastened except top two













- Uniform bottoms worn at the waistline include dress pants, dress shorts, skirts/skorts, jumpers, polo-style dresses, or capris in solid color of <u>navy</u>, <u>black</u>, <u>gray</u>, <u>green</u>, <u>brown</u>, or <u>tan khaki</u> only. \*\*\* <u>Polo-style dresses can be any solid</u> color \*\*\*
  - All uniform bottoms must be of appropriate size (no excessive sagging) and have no holes, patterns, embellishments, cargo pockets, or frayed edges. No carpenter pants.
  - Allowed fabrics: twill/ polyester/ dress cotton, colored denim, corduroy
  - Fabrics not allowed: velvet, fleece, or other fabrics (no sweat pants, pajamas, or athletic wear)
  - all shorts, skirts, skorts, and jumpers no more than 4" above knee (even if leggings are worn underneath)
  - leggings or tights of solid color/no pattern can be worn under skirts and jumpers only (not alone or as pants)



















- Outerwear Requirements (sweaters, sweatshirts, coats, or jackets)
  - all outwear must be graphic free (except for MOSAICS spirit wear).
  - outerwear with patterns, multiple colors, stripes, and small logos (such as Adidas, Under Armour, Nike, etc.) are allowed
  - all outerwear must not have rips, holes, or frayed edges.
  - outerwear is allowed to be worn inside the building; however, hoods are not to be worn while inside













#### Fridays:

• Students are allowed to wear blue jeans on Fridays with standard uniform shirts or MOSAICS spiritwear. Blue jeans are to have no patterns, no embellishments, no holes, no frayed edges, no rips, or no cargo pockets

## **Additional Notes:**

- Shoes must be appropriate for school activities- any sandals/ clogs must have back straps, heels no higher than 1½", no "wheelie" shoes or flip flops
- No dangling belts or belts over shirts
- No hats, bandanas, embellished headbands, or head coverings (except for religious or medical purposes)
- No dangling or large jewelry, including chains
- No visible tattoos or body piercings other than earrings
